***ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR CRIME AND POLICING ACT 2014
PROPOSAL TO VARY THE HEATHROW VILLAGES PUBLIC SPACES PROTECTION ORDER 2015***

Dear Sir or Madam

The Council is proposing to vary the Heathrow Villages Public Spaces Protection Order 2015 by adding the following prohibition in the Order. The proposal is to vary the Order as follows:

v. Parking a commercial vehicle in a Council operated car park associated with a Council operated leisure or Green space facility unless:

- a) The driver or passenger/s are attending the car park for the genuine use of the leisure or green space facilities provided by the London Borough of Hillingdon;
- b) The driver or passenger/s are customers of businesses within the Council operated leisure or Green space facility;
- c) Directed or authorised to enter the car park by a uniformed police officer or authorised officer of the London Borough of Hillingdon;
- d) The vehicles are used for deliveries to the leisure or green space facilities;
- e) The vehicles are used for the maintenance or repair of the leisure or green space facilities.

This variation is being considered to introduce more specific prohibitions to address particular anti-social behaviour within the ward that is affecting the use of Council operated car parks associated with a Council operated leisure or Green space facility.
